## Government-funded Tuition

Federal, state, or local governments or non-profit organizations grant subsidized tuition funds for child care and education costs. Subsidy qualifications are given to families based on criteria such as income eligibility based on family size, participation in vocational training, receiving other government aid, or serving as foster or adoptive parents.


